This Week

This week we had fun learning about the letters "K" and "L". Throughout the week we read the stories Kangaroo Kazoo and The Lamb Who Loved to Laugh. After we read each story, we practiced reading the letter poem for each letter. We had fun clapping out each word to find out how many syllables they had. Throughout the week we also worked on counting while we sang *5 Green and Speckled Frogs* and *Number Rock*.

This week we learned all about the life cycle of frogs. Throughout the week we learned that frogs start off as tiny eggs in the water, hatch into tadpoles, grow two back legs to be a froglet and then grow two front legs and become an adult frog. During our story time, we read Curious George: Tadpole Trouble, There Was an Old Lady Who Swallowed a Frog, and Rattlin' Bog. During circle time, we also learned about different animals that may live in a swamp; frogs, lizards, chameleons and snakes. During our craft time, we created 5 green and speckled frogs sitting on a speckled log, beautiful water color chameleons and slithery snakes out of toilet paper tubes. During our snacktime, we had fun making our own edible swamps. We used frosting, graham crackers, mint Oreos and gummy frogs and worms to make our tasty treat.

On Thursday, Miss Bonnie came in for Art Class and taught us all about Jackson Pollock.
