We had an amazing week learning all about colors. Throughout the week we learned a song to help us remember what objects each color was and even how to spell each of the color words. During circle time we sang "Rainbow Colors Everywhere" and "It's A Rainbow". During our story time we learned all about different shapes. We read Shape Song Swingalong, The Color Monster, The Crayon Box That Talked, and Snippets.

Throughout the week we worked on different crafts. We practiced our scissor skills by cutting snippets of paper for each color of the rainbow. When we were done creating our snippet shapes, we glued them onto a line to design a beautiful rainbow. We even had the chance to glue together shapes, gems, and pipecleaners to create a one-of-a-kind shape robot.

During Social Skills class we learned about Tucker Turtle. Tucker Turtle taught us how to calm down when we are getting upset. Turker Turtle says we need to 1: Stop our bodies, 2: Go into our turtle shells, 3: Take three deep breaths, 4: come out of our turtle shell and select a solution. When we finished our story, we had the chance to color in Tucker Turtle's calm down techniques.
