News From the Nest

Pumpkins, pumpkins, pumpkins! This week at school, we talked all about pumpkins! During circle time we discussed what a pumpkin looks like, smells like, feels like, and even what a pumpkin tastes like!

On Tuesday, we read a story called, Pumpkin Jack. In this story, we read about what happens to a pumpkin after you carve it. We listened and saw the transformation from a pumpkin, to a jack-o-lantern, to then watching it rot away and go into the dirt.
